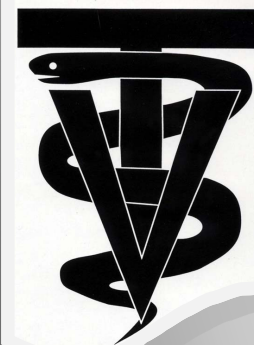

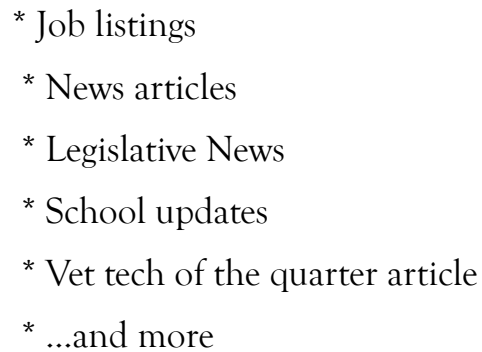




Getting involved in the state association will allow you to receive information on changes as they are handed out.
